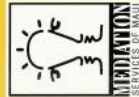

is a 501(c)3, community-based organization established in 1982. Our mission is to provide, teach, and facilitate appropriate dispute resolution for people of all ages. We handle a wide variety of conflicts for families, neighborhoods, businesses and government agencies. We bring people together to find their own best solutions, a process that promotes respect, communication and peace.

In addition to mediation, MSM offers meeting facilitation, community education, and mediation training. We are expanding in exciting new directions, including a Teen Program and an Elder Mediation Program.

What is mediation?

Mediation is an effective, inexpensive way to resolve a dispute quickly. It is a voluntary and confidential process in which two or more people meet face to face to work out a mutually acceptable solution to their problem. They are assisted by a neutral third party, called a mediator.

How do you become a mediator?

Graduates of MSM's 40 hour Basic Mediation Training can apply to become volunteer mediators with the agency. MSM offers this training once per year. Dates are tentatively set for September. Dr. Peter Adler

1979 Oahu opens Neighborhood Justice Center with Peter Adler, Executive Director.



Mike Hazama

1981 Peter Adler and Ray Taibbi come to Maui to present the first mediation training to 25 participants. Among the participants were: Mike Hazama, Sandy Shiner, Dr. Elizabeth Ayson, Priscilla Erece Veilleux and Tamara Horcajo. Charter of Incorporation is signed by Don Cataluna, John Wilt and Mike Lyons (August 17).



Sandy Shiner

1982 "Maui Neighborhood Justice Center" opens at Maunaloa campus in Makawao. Mike Hazama is Executive Director, Sandy Shiner and Ruben Hall are Intake Coordinators. IRS recognizes the agency as a tax-exempt, 501c3 organization. (April 8) Mediations are free and completely voluntary.



Mike Lyons

1982 Val Muroki begins training peer mediators at Maui High School in a program called "Project TOPS" which remained active until 1991.



Don Cataluna

1983 Board of Directors passes a resolution to change the agency's name to "Mediation Services of Maui." IRS recognizes new name for the organization in 1990.



John Wilt

1984 With help of MSM, Mediation Center of Molokai opens.

1985 Agency moves into J. Walter Cameron Center in Wailuku.



Val Muroki

1987 Domestic/Divorce Program begins. Partnership with Family Court begins, a first in the state. Mediation is expected in all those divorcing couples where custody is a primary issue.



Priscilla Erece Veilleux

1988 Testimonial Dinner for Mike Hazama at Ming Yuen Restaurant. Marty Bright, and then Vernyce Dannels becomes Executive Director.

1989 Sue Kiang becomes Executive Director

1989 Meeting Facilitation program begins, allowing groups to have a neutral facilitator for community-level disputes.

1990 MSM becomes a Maui United Way agency.

1991 Condominium Mediation Program begins in partnership with Hawaii Real Estate Commission.

1992 MSM holds 10th Anniversary Dinner Dance Celebration at Maui Sun Hotel, Kihei.



Timeline of the agency, cont.



1992 MSM becomes part of "Mediation Centers of Hawaii" a collaboration of the six programs statewide. The collaboration applies for statewide contract from the Judiciary.

1994 Kat de la Cruz becomes Executive Director.

1995 Claudia Wahl becomes Executive Director.

1996 District Court Mediation Program begins. Judge Douglas Ige is first judge on Maui to order mediation for small claims, regular claims and non-violent TROs. Caseload doubles in one year. Agency expands into 3 office spaces.

1997 Kit Gillette becomes Youth Coordinator.

1997 MSM chosen for Liberty Bell Award from the Hawaii Chapter of the American Bar Association for outstanding community service.

1998 Civil Rights Mediation Program begins in partnership with the Hawaii Civil Rights Commission.

1998 Special Education Mediation Program begins in partnership with the Department of Education.

1998 New Logo introduced.

1999 Small Business Partnership Program begins, helping businesses to develop interpersonal business charter.

1999 Restorative Justice Program begins (also known as "victim/offender mediation dialogue").

2002 MSM chosen for Liberty Bell Award from the Hawaii Chapter of the American Bar Association for outstanding community service.

2002 20th Anniversary Celebration held at Iao Park.

2003 Kim Compcoc becomes Executive Director.

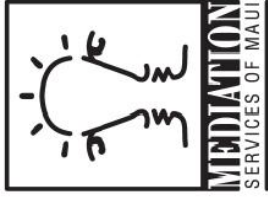
2004 Claudia Wahl and Diane Petropulos present Basic Mediation Training.

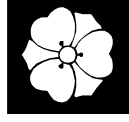
